7. Explain the contribution of Buddhism and Jainism to Bihar's historical identity.
8. Discuss the importance of Pataliputra as an ancient political and cultural centre.

1. How can Bihar improve learning outcomes in school education?
2. Discuss the opportunities and risks of artificial intelligence for public administration.
3. Evaluate the importance of renewable energy for energy security.
4. How does migration affect the economy and society of Bihar?
5. Discuss the significance of river interlinking and basin-level planning.
6. Explain the importance of transparency and citizen charters in governance.
7. Assess the role of SHGs in rural livelihood generation.
8. How can tourism become a driver of local employment in Bihar?

8. Discuss the role of electric mobility in reducing pollution.
